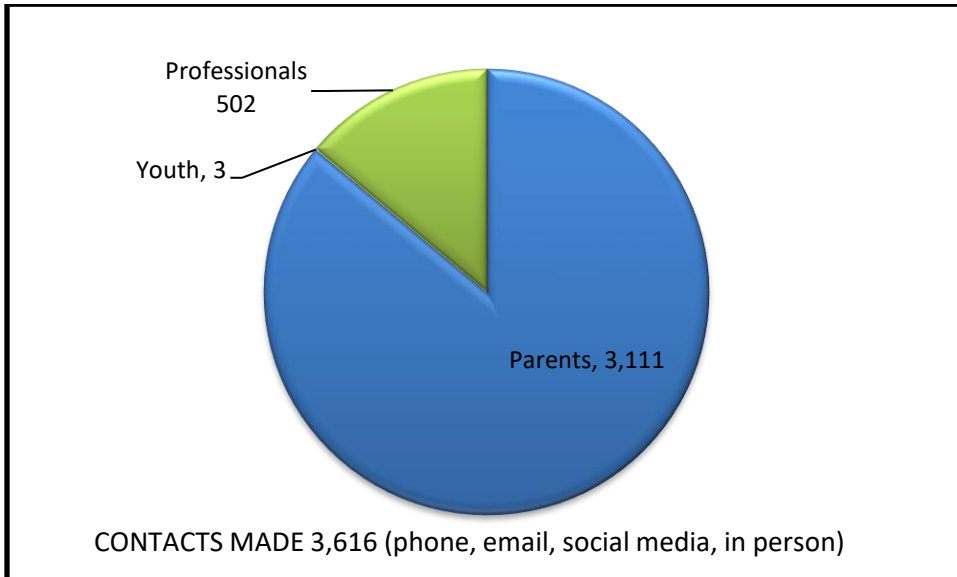

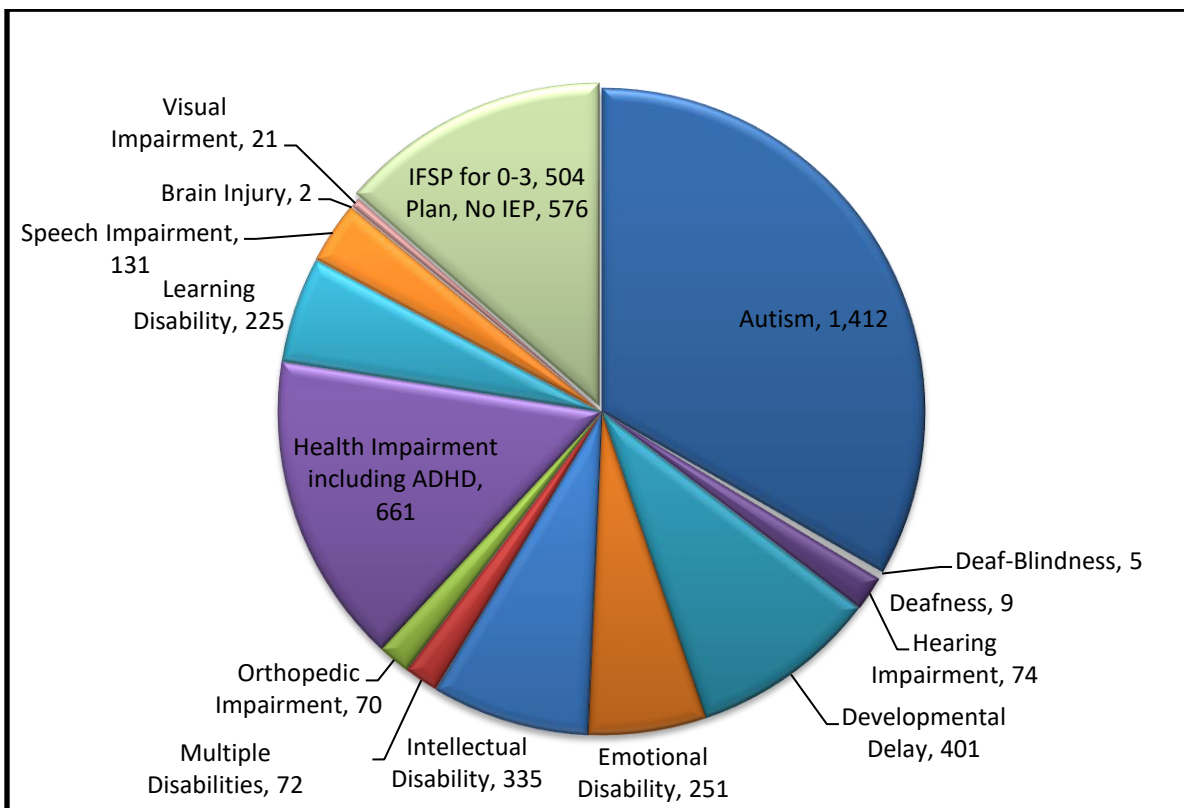

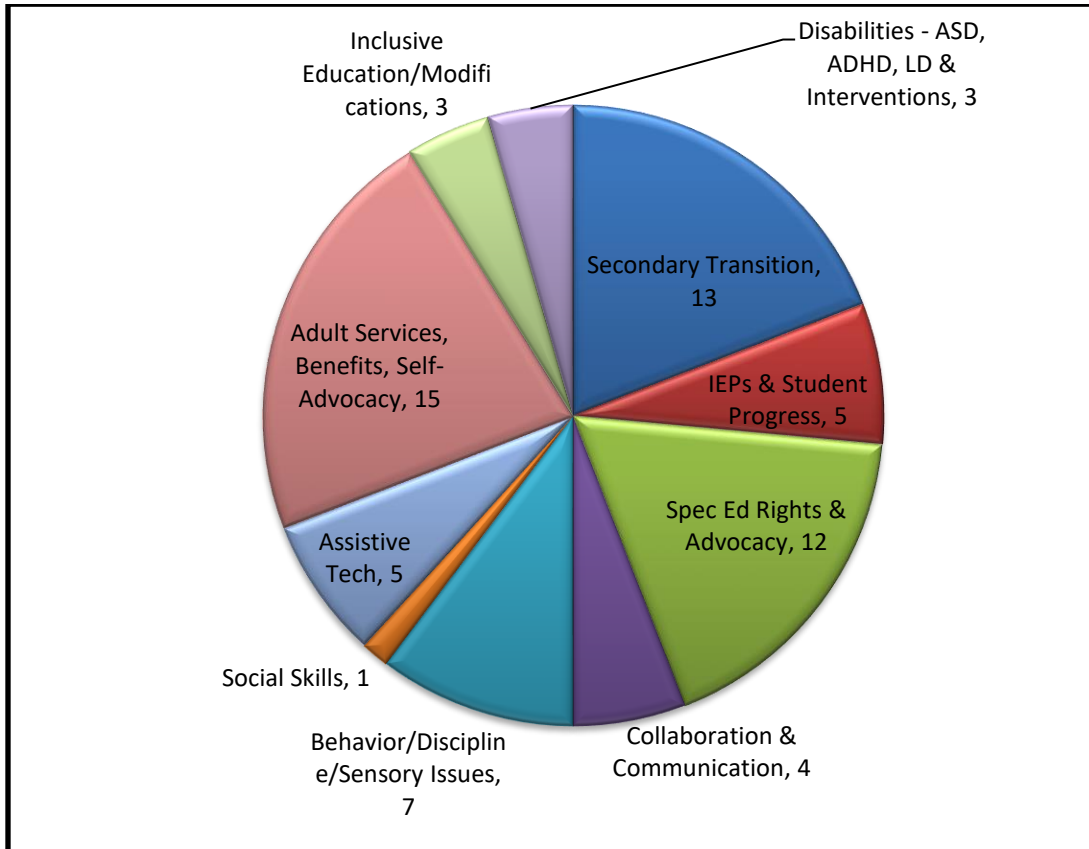

DISABILITY OF CHILD – duplicated count (additional 89 - disability not disclosed) Parents who contacted Family Matters or attended a training

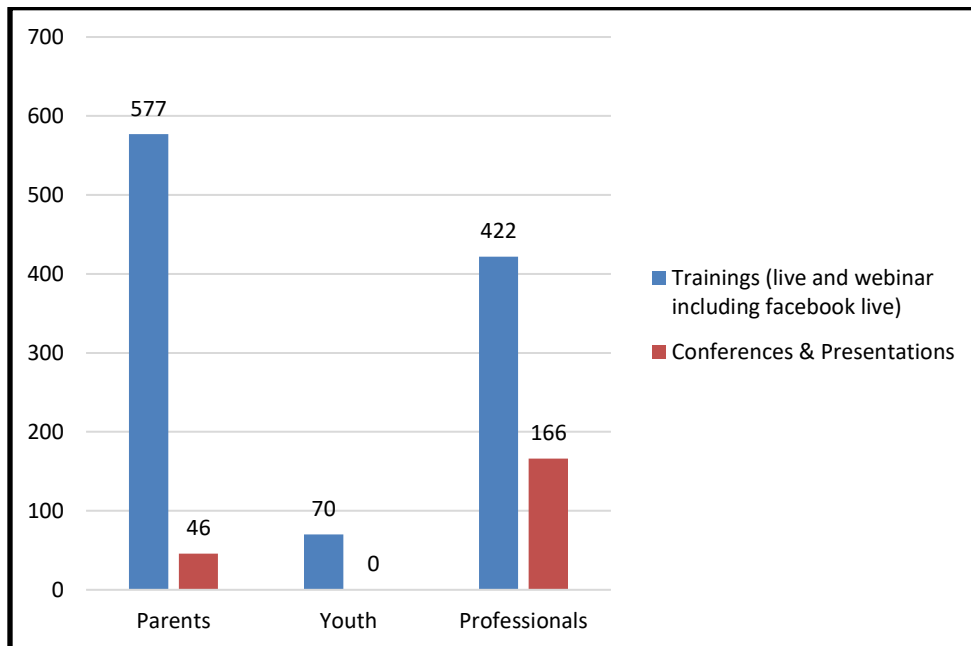


Topics Presented at 68 Trainings (live trainings and webinars)
